We want to break the vicious circle of poverty and dedicate our work to the lowest members of society through the construction of a day-care centre in Kathmandu. Our vision is to help children from an early age to enable them to have a better future and perspective for their lives.

The living conditions provided through our Child Day Care Centre "Growing Flower," will supply all the basic needs of the children including:

- access to medical care
- encouragement and support in their physical development
- opportunities for personal development
- an opportunity to grow up in an exciting and stimulating environment
- the ability to build stable relationships with a carer
- a caring and empathetic education
- development of long-term, future-oriented perspectives
- protection from violence, crime, exploitation and neglect

In addition, it is important to involve their parents and other family members in our work so that we are able to intervene in crisis situations within the family.

Even after they have completed kindergarten, we continue to support the children and their families through sponsorship.

## Music Camp

This project is primarily targeted at disadvantaged orphans and street children.

Different castes and social groups are brought together in the Music Camp through social interaction through music, dance, sports and handicrafts.

The emerging group dynamics can resolve the divisive caste rules, stigmas and discrimination.

The Music Camp facilitators are able to creatively guide and steer the teamwork using the interests and experiences of the participants. The results will be a combination of:

- Learning and teaching
- An experience of personal success and sense of community
- Security and safety.

## the situation in Nepal

Nepal is one of the poorest countries in the world.

- Child mortality rate in children under 5 lies at 6%.
  - 50% of children are malnourished.
  - 2.6 million children in Nepal have to work to ensure the survival of the family.
  - Only half of the children in Nepal reach the fifth grade and only one quarter of the girls are enrolled in secondary education.

Many children grow up working in factories, on street or working for their parents. They suffer from an inadequate supply of basic, daily needs and lack encouragement and support. Only a small number of children have the chance to complete their education. Often, a gradual transition into child labour takes place.

We want our projects to be self-sustaining and enable children and young people to access various areas of education. Education is an essential and important step in enabling children to find a way out of poverty.
