Winter Education Program

A week-long Winter education program (tuition classes) has been conducted for 18 scholarship children from Saraswati Secondary School in January 2022. Along with educational support, the children also received individual and group counseling. They participated in arts, fun games, handwriting and many other activities. We are thankful to the School Administration for providing access to the school premises for this program.



Career Orientation Workshop

In May 2022, after completing the final exam of Grade 10, 8 of our scholarship children participated in a Career Orientation Workshop which was facilitated by General Secretary of OLOW Mr. Sunil Lama. The children discussed, brainstormed, and planned about their career and trained for application writing and job interviews.





Youth Vocational Training

Class 10 graduates Kamal and Niru decided to pursue an apprenticeship. Kamal took a 34-day course to operate a JCB excavator, while Niru completed a three-month course as a cook, followed by a month-long internship. Our mentors at OLOW support both of them, as they are looking for starting their careers.







Graduating ceremony of women literacy program

In May 2022, the certificate handover for the 6-month literacy program for women took place in the presence of the chairman of District 4 of Madhyapur Thimi, in which a total of 13 women successfully participated. Congratulations to All!



Women Skill Training

15 women took part in a 15-day "bead-making course" combined with entrepreneurship training. Through the course, the women have the opportunity to improve their income by making pearl necklaces. In addition to imparting technical know-how, the exchange between the women leads to more self-confidence and a strong network to support each other.



School Scholarships

Currently, OLOW has awarded 74 school scholarships to children. At the beginning of each school year in April, uniform sets are handed out in the presence of the school management and a representative of the community. In addition, we do provide stationery to our school scholarship children four times a year.

Early Childhood Development (ECD) class set up

OLOW supported Shree Bhimdhunga Secondary School to set up an Early Childhood Development class in February 2022. More than 35 children benefited from new flooring and furnishings, 7 playground equipment, 150 story books and 16 different types of teaching tools.

Trainings for Graduates

In September 2021, Rajita and Pranisha graduated from class 12. In July this year, both took part in a Barista Training at Social Lubricant Company. Now they are prepared to work as Baristas in a cafe.

School Graduations

Of our scholarship children, a total of 12 successfully completed class 10 this year. We would like to thank all scholarship sponsors for their long-term support and for making this possible.


Thanks to our Supporters
