We thank our team in Nepal for implementing the programs for children, marginalized people, and Communities with so much positive energy and effort. Without you, this would not be possible.



In the last few weeks, we have been in contact with our supporters from Germany for a support intervention in a public school for improving the learning environment of a ECD Center (Early childhood Development). We offered a Career Orientation Workshop to class 10 Graduates and held physical and virtual educational support meetings with 5 students appearing for Grade 10 examination. This Newsletter informs you about our activities within March and April.

STATIONERY HANDOVER TO SCHOLARSHIP CHILDREN

OneLoveOneWorld provides Stationeries on quarterly basis and this month the third phase stationeries were handover to the scholarship children from different government schools in presence of Principal and coordinator of the school. Total 78 children are studying in 12 different public schools in Kathmandu Valley. OLOW conducted family and school visit as well as Parents Teachers meeting to get update of children's behavior, educational progress and family update in presence of all stakeholders.



AWARENESS PROGRAM ON SUICIDAL PREVENTION

OLOW collaborated with the Community Police Service Center in Tikhidewal to conduct an awareness program on Suicidal Prevention. The program was conducted by Dr. Basudev Karki, a Psychiatric senior consultant of a mental hospital. There were 150 participants for the program from various groups such as women, health officers, various Tole reform committees, representatives from different organizations and local residents.









CAREER ORIENTATION PROGRAM

OLOW organised a workshop on the Career Orientation Program 2023 for 5 children studying in grade 10. The children were able to develop their Career Pathways on the basis of their interests and capacities. They developed short-term and long-term goals which can support the decision making at this stage in life. We wish them all the best for the examination and for a great future either through Academic Qualification or Vocational Training.

CHILD PARTICIPATION

Sahara Waiba, our scholarship child has secured the first place in the 3rd Lalitpur Metropolitan City Mayor Cup National Full Contact Karate Championship of (35-40) kg which was organized by the Nepal Balkumari Kyokushin Karate Association from 10th to 11th March 2023 in Lalitpur in collaboration with Lalitpur Metropolitan City. NEW CHILDREN ENROLLMENT FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP 2023

In the year 2022 OLOW continued Scholarship support to 78 children and from the end of July, 2023, 14 children will be graduated after completing their schooling level. So, in the new academic session, 64 children will continue their education under the scholarship support program. On 27th March, Scholarship 2023 notice was published by OLOW in collaboration with 4 different Ward offices and due date to submit the application is 19th April, 2023. OLOW has planned to support 20 more children, especially girls in need, who are deprived of getting basic education due to various social and economic obstacles.

Executive Director, Ritu Shrestha participated in a 2 days Trauma Workshop and a day of interaction on "Meeting Fundraising Expert".



WOMEN'S DAY CELEBRATION

On 8th March, 2023 on the occasion of International Women's Day, OneLoveOneWorld participated in the Walkathon and Cycling program organized by Lalitpur Metropolitan City and on the same day Lalitpur Metropolitan City ward-14 organized the Awareness Program on the basis of the international slogan of "DigitAll: Innovation and Technology for Gender Equality" in which OLOW collaborated to celebrate the Women's Day. Along with it, program focused on Art Therapy and Voice and Queries of Women were collected and submitted to Ward -14 Chairperson to address the issues of women.

VOCATIONAL TRAINING





Pranisha and Rajita completed a 2 months barista training in The Social Lubricants Company after graduating Grade 12 under the scholarship support program. The training was followed by an internship in The Jalpa Coffee Nepal Pvt. Ltd. Pranisha and Rajita got a job opportunity in two cafes/bistros in the area. Now, both of them are earning their first income, through which they support their family and themselves.
