Dear Friends and Supporters,

Thank you for your invaluable support, allowing us to continue our programs and assist children in need. Our team in Nepal has been instrumental in implementing these initiatives with passion and dedication. Stay tuned for updates on our achievements and upcoming events that highlight the positive impact we are making together.



The month of May 2023 marked the beginning of a new educational academic session in Nepal. During this time, our focus was on providing support to our 63 Scholarship children. We ensured their school fees were covered and equipped them with school uniforms, course books, and educational materials, enough to sustain them for the next 4 months. Additionally, OLOW extended its assistance to 2 public schools, establishing Early Childhood Development (ECD) classes that foster educational development through a play-way learning approach. As part of our ongoing commitment, we continue to offer scholarships to students from public schools every two years. This year, we received a total of 57 scholarship applications from 4 different public schools.

NEW ENROLLMENT FOR SCHOLARSHIP

OLOW announced Scholarship notice for new academic session 2023-24 especially for girls. Total 57 children applied for scholarship from 4 different public schools. All applicants should fill up form format and include documents such as copy of birth certificate, parent's citizenship, recommendation from school and ward office to apply for this Scholarship. We reviewed their form, documents and visited their school and family for confirmation of the information.

25 children got enrollment for new Scholarship where 9 were boys and 16 are girls so from this academic session, OLOW will support 88 children for their Scholarship.

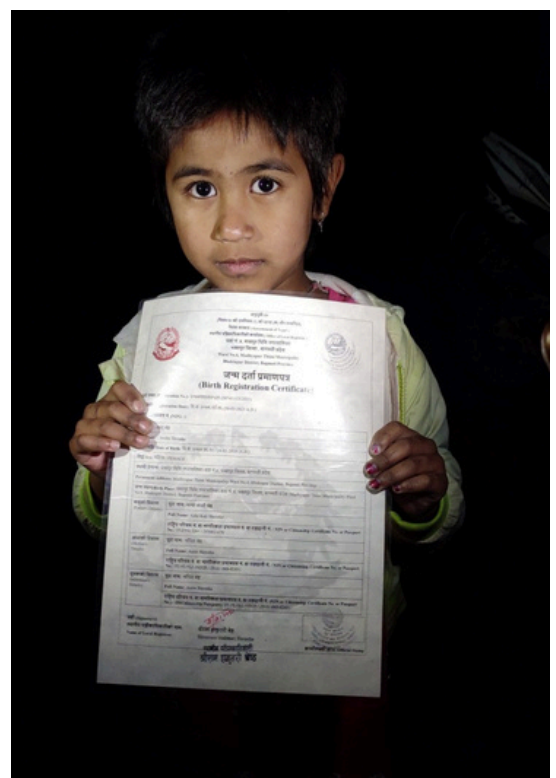


BIRTH CERTIFICATE / CITIZENSHIP

OLOW is thrilled to announce that all 83 Scholarship children have successfully obtained their Birth Certificates, with 19 of them also receiving their Citizenship Cards. Some cases faced complexities, taking over 2 years. The challenges included:

1. Parents lacking Marriage Certificates.
2. Parents without birth certificates, marriage certificates, or citizenship.
3. Unreachable fathers.
4. Economic limitations hindering travel for obtaining birth certificates.

OLOW will collaborate with local bodies and organizations to facilitate the process, offering information sharing and possible financial assistance. Our commitment remains unwavering in supporting children holistically for education and future prospects.

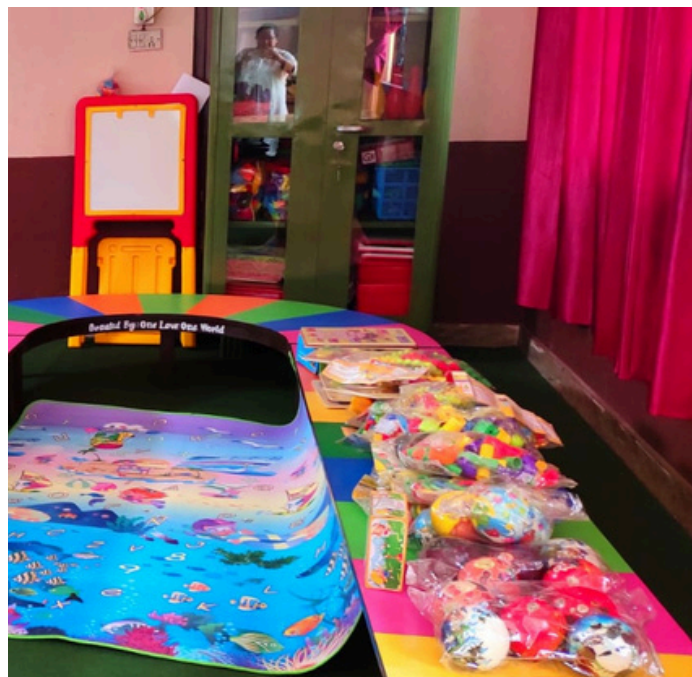




ECD CLASS SETUP

OLW extended its support to Shree Sarbeshwor Basic School in Kathmandu and Saraswati Secondary School in Lele by setting up Early Childhood Development (ECD) classes and providing necessary materials. We supplied different flooring and furnishing items, play items, story books, and educational resources to create a conducive learning environment where children can learn through play, touch, and visual engagement.

The ECD class serves as the foundation for academic education, and it is crucial to establish a strong knowledge base among the children. We hope that ECD teachers will make optimal use of the educational and play items provided by OLOW to facilitate the children's educational, cognitive, physical, and holistic development.



EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS HANDOVER

As the new academic session began, we distributed educational materials to our 63 Scholarship children enrolled in various schools. The provided materials included course books, notebooks, pens, pencils, geometry boxes, calculators, white shoes, black leather shoes, tracksuits, and uniforms. Additionally, we covered their school fees and provided extra course books. These provisions were made for our scholarship recipients from 9 different public schools.
