TRAINING OF TEACHERS

OLW organized a Training of Teachers for educators of Adarsh School and Bal Premi School, spanning July 6 to 15, 2023. We selected these two schools as some of our scholarship children go to these schools. This 10-day program engaged 17 participants, including 12 female and 5 male educators. The training focused on enhancing classroom skills, refining lab and workshop guidance, and promoting impactful student-centered interactions.

The primary goal was to equip educators with essential teaching expertise, elevating their instructional capabilities. The curriculum encompassed adept subject delivery, innovative teaching methods, engaging project design, and meticulous session planning. Professional training execution aligned with effective learning principles and the teaching-learning process. The training also emphasized accurate student performance assessment for a comprehensive educational experience.



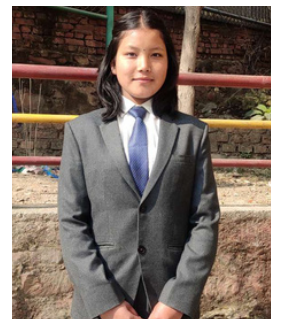
STRATEGIC WORKSHOP

OneLoveOneWorld facilitated a Strategy Workshop involving board members and staff. The workshop was complemented by a comprehensive review of the Annual Progress Report for the year 2022-23, along with the presentation of the proposed budget for the upcoming fiscal year 2023-24.



SCHOOL EDUCATION EXAMINATION (GRADE 10) GRADUATION

In 2023, our five children graduated grade 10, empowered by Career Orientation training to make informed choices about their future. Among them, three opted for vocational training (culinary arts and offset press), one pursues a civil engineering diploma, and another takes on Management studies.



AWARENESS PROGRAM

"Prevention is better than Cure." With this guiding principle, we collaborated with the Community Police Service Center to organize awareness classes for 175 students across three public schools in Kathmandu, Bhaktapur, and Lalitpur. Our mission was to shed light on critical issues and create a space for discussion about child trafficking, child marriage, gender violence, drug abuse, domestic violence, and cybercrime. Through interactive sessions and enlightening videos, we empowered these students to proactively address these pressing societal challenges and stay safe.



VOCATIONAL TRAINING

After completing grade 10, three of our children made the exciting decision to enroll in Vocational Training. Sandesh is pursuing a 1-year Offset Press program, while Sangita and Raj are immersing themselves in a 4-month Basic Cook Training course.





STATIONERY ITEMS HANDOVER TO 89 CHILDREN

We recently distributed stationery to 89 children, providing them with essential items like notebooks, pens, pencils, erasers, sharpeners, bags, two pairs of shoes, two sets of uniforms, a calculator, and a geometry box. Now, the kids are well equipped to go to school.

PROGRAM APPROVAL

On June 20, 2023, the Municipal Project Approval Committee (MPAC) meeting took place in Lalitpur Metropolitan City, approving the project planning for 2023-24. We've also obtained pre-approvals from various districts like Kathmandu, Bhaktapur, and Dhading, enabling us to execute programs such as Scholarships, School Support, ECD Setup Support, Awareness initiatives, General Teacher's Training, and local government collaborations in 2023-24. Additionally, on August 8, 2023, OLOW received Project Approval from the Social Welfare Council for a program with a total budget of NPR 62,25,061.04 (approximately 44,074.34 Euros) for the year 2023-24.

COORDINATION AND COLLABORATION WITH GOVERNMENT

As a member of the Child Right Committee for Ward-14 in Lalitpur Metropolitan City and Ward-13 in Chandragiri Municipality, OLOW actively engages in monthly interaction and discussion programs. On July 27th, we participated in a discussion program involving various children's organizations, organized by Lalitpur Metropolitan City. Additionally, ongoing discussions are taking place between Lalitpur Metropolitan City and local children's organizations in preparation for the upcoming "Children's Day" celebration.



LIONS CLUB KREUZTAL CHARITY

The 15th activity run of the Lions Club Kreuztal, Germany will take place on Sunday, September 17th, 2023, at 12:00 p.m. The venue is on the Eisernhardt "Faule Birke". The collected donations are going to support, among others, our projects.





NEW ENROLLMENT - SCHOLARSHIP SUPPORTERS NEEDED

In 2023, we welcomed 25 new children to our Scholarship project, bringing the total number of beneficiaries to 83 across 7 different public schools. As we continue to support these students, we are actively seeking donors who are willing to sponsor the education of these children.

On June 17th, 2023, the Khushi Child Club, involving children from the Family Reintegration Project, met at OLOW. With 6 members and advisors, they discussed family updates, education, and celebrated a grade 10 student's results. Later, they engaged in the interaction program by the Child Right Committee of Ward-14 in Lalitpur Metropolitan City, addressing Child Rights, Child Marriage, and Cyber Crime. The event showcased videos of real child protection cases, including online issues and child marriage, highlighting parental roles in prevention. We're committed to raising awareness, particularly among children. Through collective efforts, we can lessen crimes involving and impacting children, creating a safer world for them.
