7 DAYS WINTER EDUCATION PROGRAM

"The "Winter Education Program 2024 organized by OneLoveOneWorld for 18 children at Shree Saraswati Secondary School, Lele, appears to have had a significant impact. By providing education in subjects like English, math, science, Nepali, and social studies during the vacation period, the program not only utilized their time effectively but also contributed to their academic growth and development. Moreover, the program focus on analyzing the children's present family and educational status to plan for their betterment shows a holistic approach towards supporting their overall well-being.

EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS DISTRIBUTION

Second Phase educational materials were distributed to 89 scholarship children at their school. Providing pens, pencils, notebooks, erasers, and sharpeners ensures that these children have access to necessary educational materials is a crucial step towards breaking down barriers to learning and empowering them to reach their full potential. SCHOOL SUPPORT PROGRAM



WARM CLOTHES AND EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS DISTRIBUTED

Collaborated with Godawari Municipality and 17 like-minded organizations to distribute warm clothing, stationery, and gift hampers to 511 children from five different public schools. By providing school uniforms, sweaters, caps, shoes, socks, notebooks, pens, pencils, and daily use items, we're addressing critical needs and ensuring that these children have the resources they need to stay warm and engaged in their education. With collaborative hands, we are able to reach a broader audience and provide more comprehensive support to those in need.



SUPPORT FOR HIMALAYAN SARASWATI SCHOOL

We provided 15 school benches, 10 water purifiers, 2 seesaws, and 1 speaker to the Himalayan Saraswati Basic School in Dhading District, benefiting 143 children.
